CERTIFICATION OF RESULTS

Pursuant to a letter agreement dated February 5, 2010 and signed Barbara Gabriel of the Professional Staff Congress – City University of New York hereinafter referred to as “PSC-CUNY,” and the American Arbitration Association, hereinafter referred to as the “Administrator,” agreed to conduct an Election for Spring Chapter Officers.

Three thousand four hundred sixty four (3,464) ballots were mailed to eligible voters on Monday, April 5, 2010 as follows:

PSC-CUNY provided the Administrator with a list of persons who were eligible to vote. During the election, an additional seventy-four (74) ballot packets were issued at the request of PSC-CUNY. To be counted, ballots had to be received by the Administrator no later than 5:00 p.m. Thursday, April 29, 2010.

The Administrator received a total of one thousand five hundred and five (1,505) envelopes as follows:


