CERTIFICATION OF RESULTS

Pursuant to a letter agreement dated January 30, 2008 and signed Barbara Gabriel of the Professional Staff Congress – City University of New York hereinafter referred to as “PSC-CUNY,” and the American Arbitration Association, hereinafter referred to as the “Administrator,” agreed to conduct an Election of Officers.

One thousand six hundred thirty (1,630) ballots were mailed to eligible voters on Tuesday, April 1, 2008 as follows:

City College	581
Hunter College	857
City College Welfare Fund	192

PSC-CUNY provided the Administrator with a list of persons who were eligible to vote. During the election, an additional thirty-nine (39) ballot packets were issued at the request of PSC-CUNY. To be counted, ballots had to be received by the Administrator no later than 5:00 p.m. Monday, April 28, 2008.

The Administrator received a total of five hundred thirty (530) envelopes as follows:

Of the envelopes received by the Administrator, four (4) envelopes from City College were set aside and neither opened nor counted for the following reasons:

- 2 Not on List of Eligible Members
- 2 Duplicate and Original Packet Received from Member.
One packet from each Counted.

The counting of the ballots took place at 10:00 a.m. at the offices of the Administrator, 1633 Broadway, New York City, New York on Tuesday, April 29, 2008, in the presence of observers. During the course of the count, one (1) envelope from City College and one (1) envelope from the City College Welfare Fund were found to be empty.

The secrecy of the ballot was maintained at all times. The results are certified to be as follows:


